

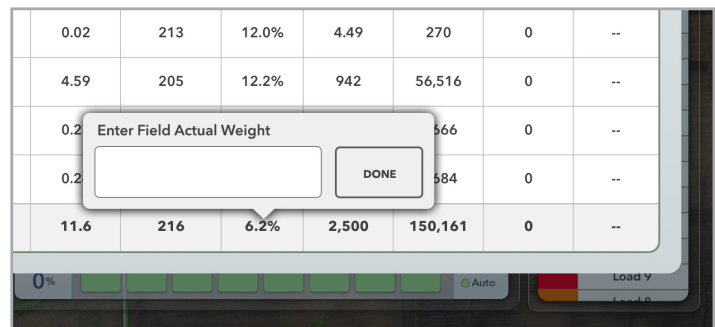
» Adjusting Yield Data



At times it's necessary to adjust the yield data being collected by the Climate FieldView™ Cab app. There are two primary ways to adjust the field actual weight for farmers using Climate FieldView™ Drive:

+ Option 1: In the Load List While Connected to a FieldView™ Drive

While connected to a FieldView Drive (not during harvest), tap on the “Load” button towards the bottom of the Map page. Next, tap on the row at the bottom of the Load List called “Combine Totals”. Enter the Field Actual Weight into the text box that pops up and tap “Done”. Note that for farmers using multiple combines, this should be the total weight collected by the current combine in the current field.



This will adjust the yield data collected for this field so that it matches the field's actual weight.

+ Option 2: From Data Manager on FieldViewPlus.com

Visit the Data Manager page on FieldViewPlus.com and click “By Combine” at the top of the table. In the row showing the combine that collected the yield data to be adjusted, click on the cell under the column “Combine Total”. Next, enter the total actual weight collected by the combine and hit the “Enter” key.

Field	Acres Harvested	Mass	Combine Total
Example Client / Example Farm / Smith Field	245.5	2,883,965.7	2,885,931
Example Client / Example Farm / Three Hills	34.4	367,446.0	
Example Client / Example Farm / Smith Field	236.4	2,920,279.9	0.0

This will adjust the yield data in the field listed in the field column to match the combine's actual collected weight.
