

How to Import Custom Maps into FieldView

Summary: FieldView Plus users can use the FieldView website to upload Shape Files and transfer them wirelessly to their iPad to display as Imported Maps within FieldView (version 2.18+) using these steps.

Step #1: Upload Shape Files on the Map Importer Page of the FieldView Website.

- Login to <http://fieldviewplus.com> and navigate to Data-->Import.
- Click on “Add Files” and select the desired Shape Files from your PC. You must select all components of the shape file (.shp, shx, and dbf) or you can select a .zip file that contains all of the files.
- A dialog box may appear prompting you to associate any unassigned maps to specific fields in your account. Once all maps have been assigned to fields, the files will upload and you will see each Imported Map displayed in the table.
 - Maps are not year specific, so if you need to differentiate year you will want to rename the map to include the year (see below for editing the map name)

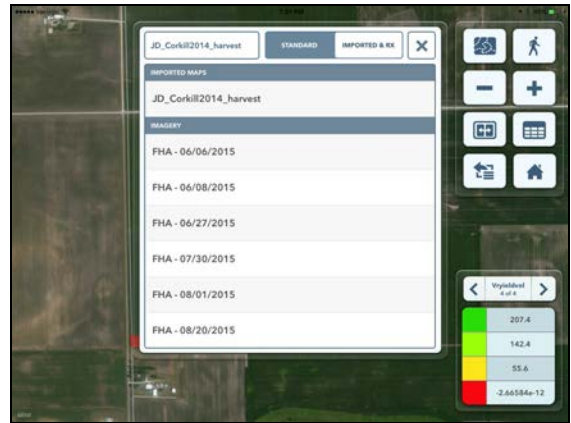

Step #2 – Edit information about the Imported Maps as necessary

- Edit the Map Name appropriately – this is what will display in FieldView App.
- The Field will assign Client, Farm, and Field automatically if a spatial match is found – otherwise it will prompt you to assign maps to a field upon import.

Step #3 – After next CloudSync, the Imported map is viewable in the FieldView App (version 2.18+)

- Toggle the Map Selector from “Standard” to “Imported & RX” to see the imported maps.
